For many decades, Oest has also been working with high-quality fuels, focussing on sustainability, alternative raw materials and renewable solutions.

Oest pioneered the market introduction of environmentally friendly special fuels for 2- and 4-stroke engines back in the 1990s. The Oest Oecomix 2T® and Oest Oecokraft 4T® makes the company a market leader in Germany as a manufacturer of special fuels. Research into further synthetic fuels and e-fuels is high priority at the company.

In addition to all its traditional fuels, Oest also supplies synthetic fuels as HVO (Hydrotreated Vegetable Oils) or GTL (Gas-to-Liquid).

Green Mobility Future initiative

Oest supports the Green Mobility Future initiative as a supporting member. The initiative works to support scientists and deliver public relations to raise awareness of alternative fuels. Instead of a one-sided focus on e-mobility, it focuses on targeted competence management for sustainability, e-fuels, bio-fuels, renewable energies and the bio-economy.




Innovative solutions for specific customer requirements and processes

In a bold and pioneering move, Georg Oest founded a factory for the production of technical oils and lubricants in 1915, in the middle of World War I – and the first company, Georg Oest & Cie, was born with the very first brand, Östol. Today, this is reserved exclusively for Oest's high-quality Oldtimer oils for vintage cars.

Despite the adverse conditions, the company founder carefully and single-mindedly laid the foundations for healthy and sustainable growth. In addition to an economically sound foundation, Georg Oest also created a tradition of innovation and a self-image as a flexible medium-sized company in the mineral oil industry.

Hugo Oest, son and successor of the company founder, led the expanding company through the post-war years with reliable continuity. He set the course for modern management with a farreaching whitepaper which sees humans at the centre of economic success. Motivated, creative and dedicated employees were, are and continue to be the key factor to success.
